APPENDIX
Requirements to a Consultant for Offshore Development Concept Study for
“F” Project

- (1) Scope of Work
 - a. Reviewing for an applied development concept of “F” project
 - b. Recommendation for feasible and viable optional development concepts
 - c. Comparison of Screening-out development options for “F” project in terms of technical feasibility and economical viability
 - d. A final report submitted to CPC within two weeks after last consultancy working day

- (2) Consultancy Working Period
 - a. During: eight (8) weeks
 - b. Early Dec 2007 – Jan 2008

- (3) Consultancy Working Location: CPC Head Office Building Taipei

- (4) Consultancy Working Scheme and Schedule
 - a. A kickoff meeting will be required at first day
 - b. A task force team of “F” project will be available to support and/or coordinate
 - c. At least one week at the beginning and the end shall be working together with CPC team

- (5) Information and Data Submitted by CPC: A Development Feasibility Report and Any Required Relevant Information Will be Provided by CPC

- (6) Qualification: Three (3) Years Experience or more in Offshore Development Planning or Development Concepts Screening

- (7) Payment
 - a. Daily payment basis: NT\$9,810 (about US\$300)
 - b. Business class flight fare compensated
 - c. Hotel accommodation compensated
 - d. Local transportation fee compensated
